In another of His little stories, Jesus says that there are also a lot of trees growing in the Big Messy Garden that we see on Earth.

Now of course there a lot of regular trees in our world, like oak trees and pine trees and all the rest. There are also lots of pear trees, peach trees, orange trees,

and many other kinds. There are a lot of nice trees in the world.

The one kind of tree we don't have around anymore is the Tree of Life. Nobody has seen that one anywhere on Earth in all the years since Adam and Eve got tricked by the Devil and fell into sin.

But Jesus says that all the grown-ups on Earth are like trees too. Jesus says

that some of the grown-ups are like good trees that have a lot of fruit on them, but other grown-ups are like bad trees that are dry and all dead inside, and those bad trees have never grown any fruit.

Jesus says that the grown-ups have to be careful to have fruit, so that God will choose to take those people to Heaven, and so that He will some day re-plant them in the New Garden that He will make. That happens when Jesus comes back to Earth again, to get rid of the Ugly Old Garden. Some day Jesus is going to get remove the Ugly Old Garden from the Earth, and replace it with the New Garden that God wants us to have.

Jesus also tells a story about how all the bad trees will be burned up with fire. Jesus says the trees that never had fruit are only dead wood, dried up and worthless. And Jesus says that God will cut down all the bad trees and throw them into a furnace where they will burn forever.

He's talking about Hell, a place where all the bad grown-ups will be sent. All the bad grown-ups in the world are like bad trees that God wants to take out of His garden. They are kind of like weeds that need to be pulled out of the world and gotten rid of.

You may have heard about some of the bad things these grown-ups are doing in today's world, if you have ever looked at a newspaper or a television or the internet.

Jesus talks a lot in his stories about Hell, something that only grown-ups have to worry about.

A person has to hate God's Holy Spirit and say "no" to God before they get sent to Hell, and little children just never do that. So children don't have to worry about Hell. But Jesus says that all the grown-ups do need to worry about it. God says in the Bible that grown-ups need to be as innocent as Jesus and as little children... or they may go to a horrible place of suffering called Hell.

Jesus says it's a place of "Outer Darkness," where there will be lots of

crying and lots of grown-up people feeling sorry about all the bad things they did.

That's what happens to all the bad trees in the Big Messy Garden... all the bad grown-ups who hurt people and did bad stuff. Those are the trees that never had any fruit, the ones made of dead wood, all dried out and worthless. They get burned

up in the furnace of Hell, and they will be forever cut off from God's New Garden.

Those bad grown-ups are going to be kept away from God and Jesus forever. Jesus doesn't want to ever have to see them again, so He gives them what He calls "the place where they belong." Judas is there too.

It's kind of like a special place for them. I guess you could call it a Forever Bad Garden for all the bad grown-ups. It's a place where they will live forever in Darkness, where they will never again have a chance to see the Light of Jesus Christ.

I guess they will wish they could be innocent again, won't they? But by then it

will be too late for them. It's too late then for those grown-ups to be sorry about the bad lives they had on Earth. It's too late then for them to even start believing in Jesus, so they can never change. Those grown-ups go to Hell because they were never made innocent by the blood of Jesus— so they can never go back to being the innocent little child that God wants us to be.

But all little children who die early are like Enoch, very much loved by God. They get to become seedlings in God's New Garden.

The New Garden of God is to be lighted by the Light of Jesus. He is the Sun of Heaven and the Light of the World, the Holy One who gives warmth and strength to all the plants and trees in His New Garden.

All this happens when Jesus makes the New Earth that He has promised for us. The New Garden is going to be a really wonderful place.

What's great is that no one who lives there is ever sick or sad anymore. There's no more suffering or sickness, no more pain, and no more crying. There's no more hurting in God's New Garden... and there are no more tears. Nobody ever gets tired of living there, because it's such a wonderful place.

So the answer to your question is: Yes, all kids go to Heaven when they die. That's happy news, isn't it? But there's more good news...

Grown-ups can go to Heaven too, if they are just as innocent and trusting as little children. And when they trust in Jesus as Savior and Lord, that is just how God The Father in Heaven will see them.

Somebody says, "Are we there yet?"

Nope, we still aren't there yet. We're still not finished with your story. It's just...
